FROM METRO NEW YORK CITY
NY Thruway (I-87) north to Exit 24 (Albany). Continue on I-87 North to Exit 30, west on Route 73 for 16 miles, right onto Route 9N north for 6 miles, left onto Route 12/83 for 3.7 miles to Whiteface Chalet.

FROM MONTREAL
I-87 south to Exit 34, left onto Route 9N south, right onto Route 86 west to Wilmington. Left at gas station onto Springfield Road, 2 miles to the Whiteface Chalet.
